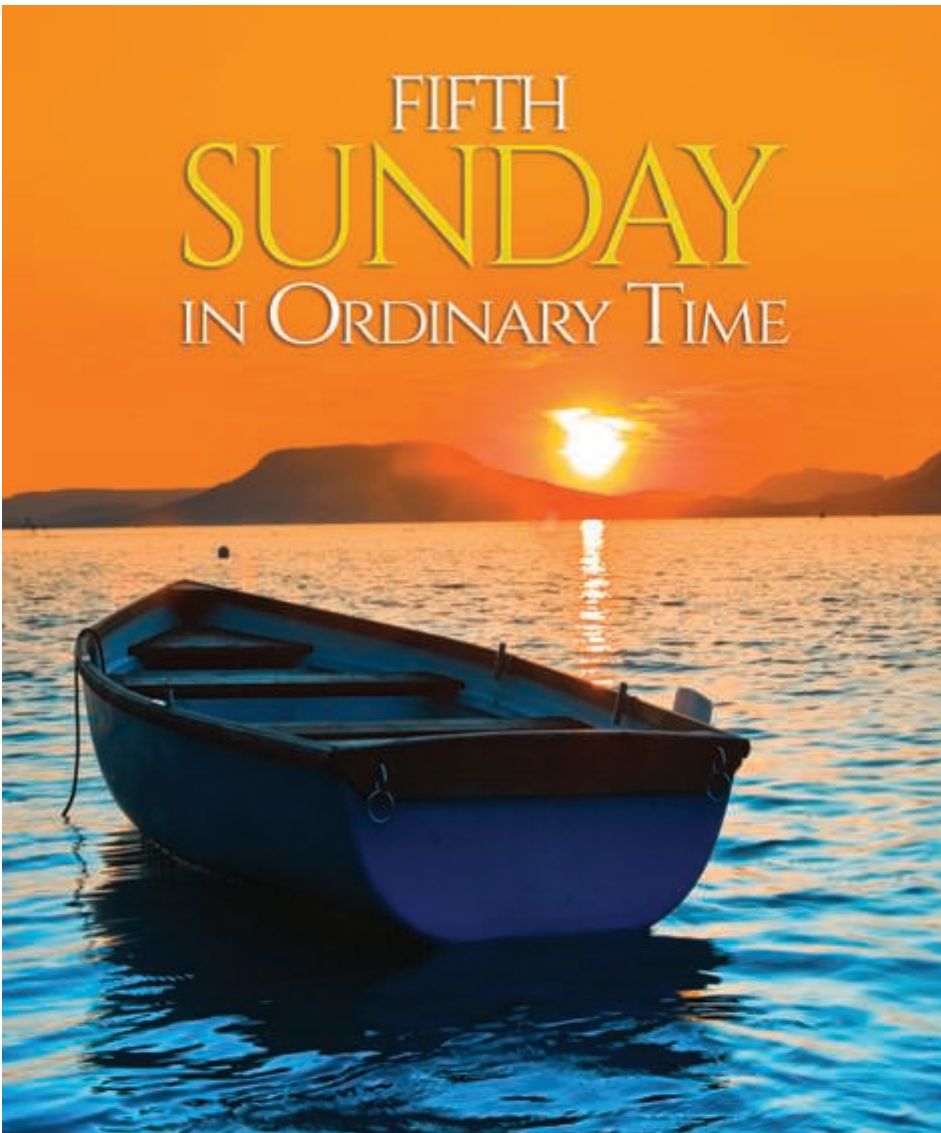

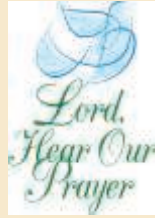

"Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men."

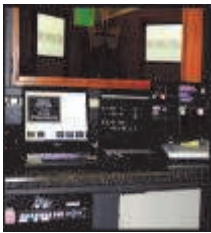

Like Paul, we are called to receive this summons and live our lives in response to it.



TAIZE PRAYER

will be celebrated on
Wednesday, February 20
at 6:30 PM (Chapel).

Taize (*pronounced-- Teh-ZAY*) is an ecumenical, peaceful way to pray, using easy to learn musical chants, silent meditation, and scripture readings... a meditative, common prayer. Gathered in faith, Christians come together to sing uncomplicated repetitive short songs, like breath prayers, uncluttered by too many words, allowing the mystery of God to become tangible through the beauty of the Spirit in its simplicity. A few words sung over and over again (mantra) reinforce the meditative quality of prayer. They express a basic reality of faith that can quickly be grasped by the intellect, and will gradually penetrate the whole being. For in-depth information visit <http://www.taize.fr/en>. The Bishop's Appeal is an annual campaign that supports the ministries of the Diocese. It does not pay the Bishop's salary and has never been used to pay any legal settlements. The Appeal provides support to diocesan ministries reaching out to thousands of people each year. These ministries include Catholic Charities, Catholic Schools, *The Compass*, and the Emmaus Lay Ministry Formation program, to name a few.

It is our continuing pledge to you to use all the funds received during the 2018 Bishop's Appeal to provide these services and meet the needs described on our web site at www.catholicfoundationgb.org/appeal.

Last year our parish goal was \$92,571. Nativity Parish collected \$86,118 with a shortfall of \$6,453. Nativity received 434 total gifts, 386 parishioners gave \$36,118 averaging \$94 and 48 parishioners gave \$50,000 contributing 58% of our goal.
