The Treasurer Trustee assists the Pastor in parish financial activities including the custody of funds, assets, banking, credit and insurance. The Treasurer Trustee is a full member of the finance council and represents the parish as a member of the parish corporation. The term of office is two years with a limit of three successive terms.

Qualifications to be considered: Adult (21 years old) registered parishioner in good standing with the parish. Judy Schroeder is the only candidate running.
